Both the petitioners have got admission in BAMS/BHMS course in Ayush Jyoti Ayurvedic College, Sirsa and they have deposited the requisite fees.

The grievance of the petitioners is that Govt. of Haryana had added five new colleges for BAMS/BHMS courses and for filling up vacant seats in the said colleges, no shifting was allowed by the respondents, meaning thereby that candidates who had already got admission in the course were not allowed to shift in the newly added colleges irrespective of their being higher in merit.

Petitioners have made a representation to the official respondents in this regard and the same has been declined.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have found no ground to interfere as it is completely in the domain of the official

respondents to allocate colleges to the students. Moreover, the petitioners themselves have accepted their admissions in the earlier allotted colleges and have already deposited the fee. Now they cannot agitate their claim for re-shifting as a matter of right. However, if the seats are available in the colleges where petitioners are desirous of taking admission, respondents are at liberty to consider their case for re-shifting if otherwise permitted by law.
