In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is for the grant of Assured Career Progression Scheme, which had come into existence with effect from 01.01.2006.

The petitioner claims that under the said Scheme, he was entitled for the benefit of the said Scheme before he superannuated on 31.07.2007.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not able to explain the delay of ten years before the petitioner issued a legal notice dated 22.12.2017 (Annexure P-2). Still in the interest of justice, once a legal notice has been issued by the petitioner, the authorities are bound to reply to the same by passing appropriate order.

Therefore, competent authority, which is to take action on the legal notice, is directed to pass appropriate order on the legal notice (Annexure P-2) dated 22.12.2017 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
