The petitioner/Aryawart Shiksha Samiti has filed the instant petition praying for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 i.e. the Director, State Council of Educational Research and Training, Gurugram to approve the faculty of the college being run by the petitioner/Samiti in terms of a Letter of Intent dated 16.10.2018 issued by the National Council for Teachers Education (Annexure P-3). It is submitted by counsel that such approval at the hands of respondent No.2 is a pre-requisite for permanent recognition to be issued in favour of the petitioner/Samiti by the National Council for Teachers Education for the D.El.Ed. Course.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Nidhi Garg, learned AAG, Haryana accepts notice. A copy of the writ paper book has been furnished to learned State counsel.

With the consent of counsel for the parties, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal today itself.

Counsel for the parties are ad idem that under similar circumstances, directions had been issued by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-19204-2018 (Naveen Shiksha Samiuti Versus State of Haryana & another)** on 07.08.2018 to the Director, State Council of Education Research and Training, Gurugram to decide the representation that had been preferred by the concerned Samiti.

Furthermore, similar directions were even issued by this Court while disposing of **CWP-26400-2018 (Shri Ram Shiksha Samiti Vs. State of Haryana & others)** decided on 30.10.2018.

In view of the above and without going into the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a final decision on the representation dated 13.11.2018 (Annexure P-6) strictly in accordance with law and as early as possible and in any case, within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
