This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to handover the original documents of the property of the petitioner even bank has redeemed their charge on the property.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent-No.1 – CBI by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation. However, a direction may be issued to the concerned authority to decide the same in a time bound manner.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, perusing the petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order. It is further directed that in case the said representation is filed, the same shall be decided

by respondent No.1 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within a period of next one month from the date of receipt of the representation.
