TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA J.(ORAL)

Petitioner who is serving as a Headman-Lambardar of Village Allar, Tehsil Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, has filed the instant petition seeking quashing of complaint dated 16.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) filed against him to the Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur.

Entire case set-up on behalf of the petitioner is that the complaint is malicious and in fact has been filed by unknown persons and by forging the signatures of respondents No.4 to 8.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is of the considered view that the instant petition is wholly misconceived.

Complaint has been lodged with the Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur. Learned counsel himself concedes that the complaint has been marked to SDM towards a fact finding enquiry. Petitioner has not even been summoned by the Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur.

In a nutshell, petitioner by way of filing the instant petition has

approached this Court to exercise powers of supervision over the Deputy Commissioner in pursuance to complaint dated 16.12.2017 and the outcome of which is uncertain.

Confronted with a situation, where this Court was not inclined to intervene, learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition

Dismissed as withdrawn.
