Mr. Bedi has filed a status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Dahiya and the same is taken on record. It has been explained in the affidavit that the officer joined as Labour Commissioner on 24.01.2018. He has deposed in his affidavit that on 10.04.2018, 30.04.2018 and on 11.05.2018 he and his office took steps to try and bring about settlement on the disputes but in the last meeting held on 23.05.2018 and after the statements of all the disputing parties were recorded came to the conclusion that no settlement could be arrived at. Therefore, the recommendations made to the appropriate Government to refer the dispute to the Labour Court for determination. It is not that he sat over the file for one year without taking a decision. The competent authority in the appropriate Government is the Labour Minister. The file is marked to him and he is agreed with the

recommendations of the office that the three disputes mentioned in the affidavit have been referred to the learned Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Gurugram-2 for adjudication.

Parties may now appear before the Labour Court for further proceedings on 10.12.2018.

The only prayer in this petition was for a direction to the respondents to refer the disputes to the Labour Court for determination. In view of the fact that the reference has been made to the three disputes, this petition has been rendered infructuous.
