JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release annual increment from due date, grant 2nd and 3rd ACP Scales on redereing 20 & 24 years service on the post of Auction Recorder as well as to release revise pension, gratuity, commutation of pension and other pensionary benefits along with interest 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though petitioners stood retired on different dates on attaining the age of their superannuation. At the time of their retirement, petitioners were entitled to the pensionary benefits but the same were not released/disbursed to them. The petitioners being aggrieved of the non-disbursal of the aforesaid benefit

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were constrained to serve a legal notice upon the respondents on November 26, 2016 (P-2), but till date no response has been received. He further feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.1 to decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-2) within some specified period.

3. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated November 26, 2016 (P-2) and take a conscious decision by passing a speakinder order as per rules and regulations particularly in view of the various facts and circumstances narrated in the aforesaid legal notice (P-2), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case of non compliance of this order, petitioners shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
