The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming ex-gratia payment on account of the death of his wife, who unfortunately died on 10.06.2014, while in service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide his legal notice dated 01.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) sent to the respondents on the same claim.

Without going into the merits of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 01.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
