ARUN MONGA, J. (Oral)

Inter alia contends that as per Central Government Guidelines for providing compassionate appointments issued vide Office Memorandum dated 16.01.2013 (Annexure P-9) Sub-Clause E of Clause 18 thereof, the standard for recruitment under Group 'D' staff can be considered with greater sympathy by applying relaxed standards. Concededly, the petitioner did not qualify the 1 mile race test, which he was supposed to complete within 10 minutes. As per physical efficiency test, running of 1 mile within 10 minutes is only a qualifying test, failing which a candidate cannot be considered for appointment as Constable in ITBP. On a query posed by the Court as to how is the compassionate appointment policy dated 16.01.2013 *ibid* applicable to the Combat Forces i.e. ITBP, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach on the same cause of action with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
