The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner praying that the service rendered by him with respondent No. 2 should be taken into consideration while calculating the pensionary benefits for which he is entitled for.

In support of his claim, the petitioner has placed reliance upon a judgment of this Court passed in CWP No. 22868 of 2014, decided on 26.02.2016 (Annexure P-7).

The petitioner is seeking a writ of mandamus. There is no demand which has been made to the respondents in respect of the claim made in the present writ petition. The petitioner has directly approached this Court. On being confronted with this, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be allowed to file a representation with the respondents in respect of the claim, which has been made in the present writ petition.

In case, the petitioner files a representation in respect of the claim, which has been made in the present writ petition for counting the

service, which the petitioner has rendered with Bhakra Beas Management Board within three weeks from today, respondent No. 1 is directed to consider the claim keeping in view the judgments passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court and this Court, which have been attached with this petition as Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively, the same be decided within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the representation.

In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any relief, the same should also be released to him within a next period of three months.
