The petitioner has sought judicial review of the order dated 31.01.2017 rendered by Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (hereinafter referred to as 'the Tribunal') in OA No. 060/00097/2017.

The facts necessary for the adjudication of the present petition are that the petitioner lost his father on 23.02.1995. She attained the age of majority of 18 years on 10.10.2000. Thereafter, she moved an application seeking her appointment on compassionate ground, but the same was rejected on 10.01.2003. Thereafter, original application was filed in the year 2017 beyond the period of limitation.

The purpose of giving compassionate appointment is to enable the family to tide over the economic crisis immediately after the death of bread earner. Now, in the case, the circumstances have changed since the petitioner lost her father on 23.02.1995.

Accordingly, there is no merit and the same is dismissed.
