This writ petition has been filed with a prayer that mandamus be issued directing the respondents authorities to consider and decide the proposal submitted on development of sports facility at the site.

The prayer made before the authorities would reveal the actual reason of the petitioner coming to the Court. While making a prayer it has been stated in the representation as follows:-

“It is also important to mention that there are numerous RWAs working in our area with different agendas and motives and there is a complaint forwarded to C.M window about the complainant RWA who does not have much following among the residents. Representation to registrar of societies was also forwarded by residents of its genuineness as no proper elections have been conducted or taken place (Letter to

Registrar of Societies dated Sep.02, 2014 is attached)

which was also sent to all concerned Govt. officials.”

Evidently it is a tussle between various Residents Welfare Associations and the developer -respondent No.6 also apparently is seeking shelter behind the present petition in invoking the writ jurisdiction for some purpose. We are of the opinion that the Courts cannot be permitted to be converted into a battle field between various associations feuding for greater turf. Since the petitioner and also other associations go by the name of Residents Welfare Association suggestive of the fact that they are working to secure betterment of the residents, it would be just and appropriate if they resolve their own issues without involving the Courts.

Hence, instant petition is hereby dismissed. However, if some decision has to be taken at the end of the official respondents, the dismissal of the writ petition would not be an impediment in their way to consider the grievance of the petitioner.
