Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the pensionary benefits, which has accrued to him after his retirement on 30.11.2015.

Counsel for the petitioner states that there is no impediment or justification with the respondents to withhold the pensionary benefits. Counsel for the petitioner further states that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P-8).

Keeping in view the request made by the counsel for the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P-8) by passing an appropriate

order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case on decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
