Petitioner has preferred this writ petition seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order passed by District Registrar (Firms and Societies), Gurugram notifying the final voter list for filing objections and filing nominations for election to Governing Body of the concerned Society. It has also been prayed that respondents No.4 to 6 be directed to complete the election process forthwith.

It has been urged before the court that the order passed is arbitrary in nature. The District Registrar has erroneously restrained the defaulters of common area maintenance charges from participating in the election. The District Registrar had no authority, whatsoever, to interfere in the election process, same having been notified.

On the last date of hearing a copy of the petition was handed over to the State counsel to enable him to assist. At the outset he has submitted that petitioner has effective remedy to file an appeal before the Registrar General of Societies, Haryana (respondent No.2 herein). No clear

answer has come forth from counsel for the petitioner as regards this submission. Petition is, thus, dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy.
