The petitioner has approached this Court impugning the order dated 06.01.2015 (Annexure P-10(Colly)) by which the punishment of stoppage of two annual increments without cumulative effect has been imposed upon the petitioner. Aggrieved against the said order, the petitioner had preferred an appeal to the appellate authority on 06.02.2017 vide Annexure P-14, which is still pending.

The grievance which has been raised in the present writ petition is that neither the appeal is being decided by the respondents nor the pensionary benefits, for which the petitioner is entitled for, are being released.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the appeal dated 06.02.2017 (Annexure P-14).

In view of the request made by the counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to

decide the appeal filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that this Court expresses no opinion on the merits of the case and the claim made by the petitioner either in the present writ petition or in the appeal.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
