The petitioner-Santosh, wife of late Sh. B.S. Dhanda, has approached this Court to claim certain benefits on account of the service rendered by her late husband. In the present writ petition, the claim is for grant of ACP benefits alongwith additional increments after rendering 8/18 years of service.

The department considered the case on the representation filed by the petitioner but rejected the same on the ground that due to doubtful integrity, the husband of the petitioner could not be granted the relief, which was being claimed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the order, which has been passed by the respondents, is factually incorrect and benefits of the petitioner could not have been stopped. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a legal notice with all the grounds as to why the order of rejection is bad, has been served upon the respondents on 09.08.2018 (Annexure P-6). Learned counsel further states that the petitioner will be satisfied at this

stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide her legal notice dated 09.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) sent to the respondents.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and about the claim of the petitioner being made in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 09.08.2018 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
