Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that impugned orders Annexures P-7 and P-8 both dated 6.11.2018 have been passed without granting any opportunity of personal hearing or otherwise dealing with the contentions raised by the petitioner vide her representation dated 25.10.2018 (Annexure P-6). He further contends that certain parameters have been laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the judgment rendered in **Capt. M. Paul Anthony Vs. Bharat Gold Mines Ltd. 1999 AIR (SC) 1416** and the same have not been applied while passing both the impugned orders.

2.) In view of the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner as noticed herein-above, respondent No.3 is directed to dispose of the representation dated 25.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner by granting her an opportunity of personal hearing and by passing

a speaking order within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

3.) In view of the above, orders dated 6.11.2018 Annexures P-7 and P-8 are set aside and petition stands disposed of.
