1. The petitioner has approached this Court for a direction to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) to correct the name of the petitioner i.e. from 'Aslam Khan' to 'Mohmmad Aslam' and in the certificates issued in respect of Secondary School Examination (10th) and Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2).

2. The petitioner has tendered his duly sworn affidavit dated 19.09.2018, which is ordered to be taken on record. In the affidavit, the petitioner has sworn as follows:

- “1. That the deponent is the petitioner in the above referred writ petition. The name of the deponent is Mohd. Aslam, which is also apprehends from the Ration Card, Aadhar Card, which have been annexed as Annexure P-1 to P-6 with the writ petition.
2. That the name of the deponent has been wrongly recorded as Aslam Khan instead of Mohd. Aslam in the grade of sheet-

cum-certificate of the performance of class of 10th and 10+2, Annexure P-7 and P-8.

3. That the deponent is never known as Aslam Khan and he has never taken any undue benefit in the name of Aslam Khan and he has never been convicted by any court of law in the name of Aslam Khan.”

3. To support his case, the petitioner also annexed photocopies of his passport, Driving License and Aadhar Card.

4. In view of the contents of the affidavit as well as the documents annexed with the writ petition, the learned counsel representing CBSE states that CBSE has no objection to carry out the necessary correction, as now CBSE is rendered safe and harmless in view of depositions in the affidavit.

5. Accordingly, this petition is allowed. The respondent-CBSE is directed to issue fresh certificates in respect of Secondary School Examination (10th) and Senior Secondary School Examination (10+2) to the petitioner after incorporating correct name of the petitioner within seven days on return of the old original certificates.

6. The CBSE while issuing fresh/corrected educational certificates will record in the certificates that *‘the correction in respect of name of the candidate is as per orders of the Punjab & Haryana High Court in CWP No.4342 of 2017’*.
