JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to remove the unauthorized /illegal construction raised by respondent Nos. 3 to 5 as the same is in violation of the terms and conditions of the Municipal Corporation Act and Rules.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Municipal Town Planner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 12.11.2018 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-

Municipal Town Planner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 12.11.2018 (Annexure P-3) within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
