The grievance of the petitioners admittedly has not been adjudicated upon by authority-respondent No.3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the same also can be decided by this Court in the writ jurisdiction. However, we find that the question raised in the petition involves adjudication on facts as well as it requires reports from the lower revenue officers.

In that view of the matter, the present writ petition is not entertained and is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the concerned authority i.e. respondent No.3 and place a copy of this petition before it. The authority shall take a decision, in accordance with

law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order along with copy of the petition.

Rule is disposed of with direction as aforesaid.
