JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner was appointed as ETT Teacher by way of Direct Recruitment on regular basis on 02.02.2009 in District Cadre Gurdaspur. Her case for promotion to the post of Maths Mistress, State Level Cadre was to be considered based on a compiled seniority of ETT Teachers belonging to different districts by reference to their dates of regular appointment in each district.

The grievance is that while considering the case of the petitioner for promotion, her date of regular appointment has been wrongly assumed as 01.04.2011 instead of correct date i.e. 02.02.2009, and thereby promoted the juniors vide order dated 13.07.2018.

Upon notice, learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr.

Baljinder Singh, Assistant Director, O/o DPI (SE), Punjab states that the present writ petition has become infructuous in view of the subsequent order dated 18.12.2018 whereby the petitioner has been promoted to the rank of Maths Mistress w.e.f. 13.7.2018 with notional benefits.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes to the aforesaid submission made on behalf of the State.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
