The petitioners have made an innocuous prayer for the issuance of a direction to the official respondents, in particular to respondent No. 2-Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala to supply them certified copy of the order dated 16.10.2018 which was applied by them vide application No. 916 dated 17.10.218 because in the absence of certified copy of the order dated 16.10.2018, the petitioners would not be in a position to challenge the impugned order before the higher Court whereas at the same time respondent No. 4-Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Kurukshetra has issued warrants of possession after the order of eviction has been passed against the petitioners under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (for short 'the Act').

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this court, Mr. Anil Mehta, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5 and submitted that an appropriate direction may be issued to respondent No. 2 to issue the certified copy of order dated 16.10.2018 to the petitioners.

In view thereof, present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala, to supply certified copy of the order dated 16.10.2018, which is stated to have applied for vide application No. 916 dated 17.10.2018.

It is needless to mention that the aforesaid order shall be complied with by respondent No. 2 within a period of seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Till then, dispossession of the petitioners shall remain stayed.
