The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the retiral benefits for service which the petitioner has rendered with the respondents.

The contention as raised in the petition is that the petitioner served the respondent for more than 35 years and was entitled for payment of more than Rs.10 lacs on account of retiral benefits.

Petitioner has mentioned in the writ petition that only a sum of Rs. 1 lac was paid on the date of retirement and rest of the retiral benefits are being withheld without any justification even though there are no proceedings which are pending against the petitioner and there is no impediment in release of the same.

Petitioner has given a representation Annexure P-1 to the respondents in this regard on 11.07.2018.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass appropriate speaking order in respect of the release of the pensionary benefits of the petitioner within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

If, after passing of the order, the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within a period of next two months.
