This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for releasing the interim compensation to the tune of 50% amount claimed in the main claim petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Claim Commissioner, Haryana Old PWD (B&R) Department, Sector-19, Chandigarh to finalise the proceedings pending before him within a stipulated period.

On the other hand, learned State counsel and learned counsel for respondent No.2 state that they have no objection in case the prayer made by the petitioner is accepted.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to conclude the proceedings expeditiously preferably within four months. Further, learned counsel for the petitioner assures to assist the authorities for the settlement of the claim.
