Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents/Central Board of Secondary Education, Regional Office, Panchkula to carry out certain changes in the parentage of the petitioners pertaining to migration certificate/matriculation/+2 Examination certificates.

Counsel submits that the petitioners are siblings and insofar as petitioner No.1 is concerned, in the migration as also matriculation certificates at Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively, name of her mother is reflected as Reshma whereas it ought to be Rashma Devi. Insofar as petitioner No.2 is concerned, correction is sought in the migration certificate as also +2 certificate at Annexures P-7 and P-8 respectively wherein the father's name is recorded as Sanjeev whereas the complete name is Sanjeev Kumar.

Counsel submits that in the matriculation certificate issued by C.B.S.E. pertaining to petitioner No.2, name of the father has been correctly

recorded as Sanjeev Kumar and as such, there would be no impediment in carrying out necessary correction in the migration/+2 certificate. It is urged that inspite of approaching the respondent/Board repeatedly, no positive response has been evoked.

Counsel submits that he would be satisfied if the writ petition is to be disposed of at this stage with directions to the respondent/Board to take a final decision on the claim/prayer of the petitioners and within a stipulated time frame.

Prayer made by counsel is just and reasonable.

Accordingly, without even ascertaining the correctness of the claim made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation as regards their prayer/claim within a period of one week from today. In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, the Regional Officer, Central Board of Secondary Education, Sector-5, Panchkula, Haryana would be obligated to consider the same strictly in accordance with law and as per the relevant instructions issued by the Board on the subject and to take a final decision within a period of two weeks thereafter. The decision so taken by the Regional Officer would be conveyed to the petitioners without any further delay.

Disposed of.
