AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued the case at length, however, what has finally been concluded on the basis of the arguments, is that the petitioner is apprehensive that the observations made by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, as also the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, in the impugned orders dated 22.02.2017 and 01.05.2018 (Annexures P-4 and P-12 respectively) would have an impact upon the final order to be passed by the District Collector after the remand of the case.

This apprehension of learned counsel for the petitioner can be taken care of by making an observation that the assertions and the opinion as expressed by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, as well as the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, in the impugned orders, referred to above, shall have no bearing upon the decision to be taken by the District Collector on remand of the case as per the orders referred to above. The District Collector shall consider the claim of the petitioner and other candidates on merits prior to taking a decision on the issue of appointment of a Lambardar of Village Ferozabad, Tehsil Rania, District Sirsa.

The writ petition stands disposed of in the light of the above observations.
