The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India assailing the order dated 14.12.2017 (Annexure P-5) issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education and in terms of which request of the petitioner seeking correction/modification of his name in the matriculation/migration/subsequent certificates pertaining to 10+2 Class as regards his name from Apoorv to Apoorv Garg has been declined.

Perusal of the impugned order at Annexure P-5 reveals the basis of rejection i.e. that the request for correction does not match with the school records.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the correction from Apoorv to Apoorv Garg would be supported by other documents in the nature of Adhar Card/passport etc. He, however, concedes that the school records till date have not been updated insofar as change of his name from Apoorv to Apoorv Garg is concerned.

Under such circumstances, the impugned order dated

14.12.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Central Board of Secondary Education cannot be faulted.

Faced with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant writ petition with liberty to approach the school in question i.e. the Millennium School, Panipat, Haryana to update and make the necessary corrections in the school records and thereafter to approach the Board seeking necessary correction.

Prayer is allowed.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
