KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE: (Oral)

Admittedly, the petitioner was not a bidder in respect of the tender notice in question and, as such, has no locus to challenge the allotment of work on the basis of the financial bid submitted by respondent No.2. Merely because petitioner had submitted bids pursuant to the earlier two tender notices for the same work, which were ultimately scrapped, will also not entitle it to challenge the tender process.

The writ petition accordingly stands dismissed on the ground of locus.
