REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injuries sustained in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 21.05.2013.

The Tribunal has awarded compensation of Rs.2,91,483/-, detailed hereunder:-

1. Loss of income	Rs.25,000/-
2. Medical expenses including bills and hospitalization charges	Rs.2,01,483/-
3. Attendant charges	Rs.15,000/-
4. Special diet	Rs.5000/-
5. Pain and suffering, fracture and surgery	Rs.40,000/-
6. Loss of amenities	Rs.5000/-

Counsel for the appellant would urge that the Tribunal has not allowed any compensation for transportation charges. Compensation for loss of income to the tune of Rs.25,000/- is on lower side. The injured was 50 years of age at the time of occurrence. He suffered fracture of two vertebra of spine and 'lock mono axial pedical screw' was affixed. He remained hospitalised for about 10 days and advised rest for 15 days.

I have gone through the materials on record but find that there is no justification for enhancement of compensation or award of compensation under additional head keeping in view the amount of compensation awarded under various heads, extracted hereinbefore.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed in limine.

No order as to costs.
