The present appeal has been filed by the claimants against the award dated 16.09.2014 passed by Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Gurgaon, (for short,'the Tribunal'), whereby compensation has been awarded on account of death of Rampal S/o Mani Ram in an accident that took place on 01.06.2011.

Learned counsel for the appellants would state that the appeal has been filed by the claimants for enhancement of compensation.

I have examined the award passed by the Tribunal in the light of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court **National Insurance Co. Ltd. Vs. Parnay Sethi, 2017 SCC 1270**, and found that there is no scope for enhancement of compensation.

In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of.
