REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of death of Umesh Chander @ Umesh Batra in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 04.05.2011.

The Tribunal has awarded compensation to the tune of Rs.8,26,135/-, detailed hereunder:-

1. Monthly income of the deceased	Rs.5000/-
2. Addition in income for future prospects	30%
3. Multiplier	13
4. Deduction for personal expenses	1/3 rd
5. Loss of dependency	Rs.6,76,135/-
6. Expenses on funeral	Rs.25,000/-
7. Loss of care and guidance	Rs.25,000/-
8. Loss of consortium	Rs.1,00,000/-

I have gone through the award passed by the Tribunal but find that there is no scope for enhancement of compensation. That being so, assessment made by the Tribunal is affirmed.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal stands disposed of.
