After the matter was heard at some length, when confronted with the observation that the findings which have been assailed herein are findings of fact which can only be challenged before an authority entitled to receive evidence in appropriate proceedings and, thus, the appropriate remedy available to the petitioners would be to approach a civil Court where the questions of fact can be effectively gone into, learned counsel for the petitioners finding it difficult to assail the preposition of law sought leave of the Court to permit withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to approach the civil Court by way of a regular suit.

Prayer made is allowed.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty prayed for.
