Petitioners herein are students of B.Tech Course with the respondent No.2, Central University of Haryana, Mohindergarh.

Instant writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondent/authorities to shift the petitioners to any other Central University. Such prayer is founded on the assertion that respondent No.2/University is obligated to conform to the All India Council for Technical Education/UGC norms and which in reality are not being adhered to. Counsel submits that respondent No.2/University is lacking in terms of necessary infrastructure, adequate teaching faculty, computer facilities etc.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length and having perused the pleadings on record, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioners in the first instance ought to approach the apex body i.e. the All India Council for Technical Education/UGC as regards their grievance and for necessary corrective steps to be initiated as deemed fit.

Without going into the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the

appropriate authorities as regards their grievance including All India Council for Technical Education/UGC.
