In the present case, the petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits in consonance with the instructions of the Government as well as Circular applicable to the Battle Injured Personnel. The petitioner is relying upon the Central Civil Services (Extra Ordinary Pension) Rules, 1939 as amended from time to time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed by the petitioner in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 28.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) to the respondents which has not still been replied for by the respondents. He further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide his claim raised in the legal notice dated 28.01.2018 (Annexure P-7).

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal noticed dated 28.01.2018 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 28.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
