By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to the respondents to take action on the complaints made by the petitioner to respondent Nos.3 & 4.

Learned counsel states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Punjab, Sector 62, SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to consider and decide the complaint dated 04.09.2018 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Punjab, Sector 62, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the complaint dated 04.09.2018 (Annexure P-8) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent

authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
