In the present case, the petitioner has approached this Court for the grant of interest on the delayed payments and further a sum of Rs.1 lac as alleged as well as a sum of Rs.31680/- are yet to be paid to the petitioner out of his retiral benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served a legal notice Annexure P-9 dated 11.10.2018 to the respondents. He further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the claim raised by him in the legal notice Annexure P-9 dated 11.10.2018.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice Annexure P-9 dated 11.10.2018, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice Annexure P-9 dated 11.10.2018 within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to the monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within three months thereafter.
