The petitioner (Narinder Kaur) has retired on attaining the age of superannuation from the post of ETT Teacher with the Directorate of Elementary Education, Punjab. By filing the present petition, she is claiming the counting of her previous service rendered by her in the privately managed aided school, prior to her joining the Department on regular basis towards qualifying service for grant of pensionary benefits.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after issuing notice of motion, the necessary relief has since been granted to the petitioner.

The factual position is admitted by the respondents by filing a reply dated 08.05.2018 in Court today.
