The appellant- New India Assurance Co. Ltd. has filed the present appeal impugning the award dated 17.10.2014 passed by Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Jhajjar whereby the claim petition filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 by the respondents-claimants was allowed and the claimants were held entitled for compensation to the tune of ₹ 26,65,000/-.

Learned counsel for claimants/respondents No.1 to 3 has pointed out that the said award dated 17.10.2014 was challenged by the claimants by way of FAO No.3038 of 2015 seeking enhancement of compensation and after hearing learned counsel for the appellant and the Insurance Company, this Court has enhanced the compensation vide judgment dated 19.01.2018.

Learned counsel for the appellant does not dispute the said award.

Since this Court has already dealt with the rival contentions and modified the award dated 17.10.2014, no ground for interference is made out.

Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed.
