Petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 24.11.2018 (Annexure P-2), passed by the Superintendent, District Jail, Jhajjar, vide which, the request of the petitioner for temporary release to attend his serious ill father, has been declined on the ground that the petitioner has neither completed one year imprisonment after conviction nor he earned his first annual good conduct remission report.

A report from Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Chhochhi, District Jhajjar duly attested by the Nambardar, Village Chhochhi (Jhajjar) has been filed in the Court today, which is taken on record. Report shows that father of the petitioner-Jit Singh is suffering from Lung Cancer for last 1 ½ years and he is getting treatment of the said disease. Jit Singh has three sons-Vijender, Narender and Dharmender and one daughter-Chandrawati along with their family. It is stated that there are other family members to look

after Jit Singh-father of the petitioner.

The petitioner has neither completed one year imprisonment after conviction nor he earned his first annual good conduct remission. Therefore, there is no ground to grant emergency parole to the petitioner on account of illness of his father.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
