Petitioner seeks four weeks parole for attending wedding of his nephew (sister's son), fixed for 9.12.2018. Superintendent, District Jail, Kurukshetra (respondent No. 2) has declined parole on the ground that petitioner (prisoner) has not completed one year of imprisonment after conviction and he has to earned his first annual good conduct remission. The marriage is stated to be fixed on 9.12.2018 i.e. day after tomorrow. Next two days, i.e. 8.12.2018 and 9.12.2018, are holidays. State is to be given time to file reply and case is to be fixed at earliest on Monday. Otherwise, marriage is of nephew of petitioner which can be conducted without him. Petitioner should have come well before time. Moreover, as per rule, he is not entitled to parole unless he completes one year of sentence. It being so, there is no illegality or infirmity in impugned order. Petition is therefore dismissed.
