Challenge in the instant writ petition is to the order dated 28.10.2018 (Annexure P-10) issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education and in terms of which the request of the son of the petitioner seeking correction as regards his name from Bikramjeet Singh to Bikramjeet Singh Bhangu in the Matriculation as also Senior Secondary Examination certificates has been declined.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard and the case paper book has been perused.

A bare reading of the impugned order dated 28.10.2018 reveals the basis for declining the request of the petitioner i.e. 'the school record does not support the desired correction.'

It is the case of the petitioner herself that her son was a student of International Public School, Kurali, District S.A.S. Nagar, Punjab. Even though the case set forth by counsel is that in all the supporting documents

in the nature of passport, Aadhaar Card etc. name of the son of the petitioner is reflected as Bikramjeet Singh, yet it is conceded that the school records as of date have not been updated/corrected and the name of the son of the petitioner continues to be Bikramjeet Singh.

Under such circumstances no infirmity is found in the impugned order dated 28.10.2018 at Annexure P-10.

Accordingly while declining to interfere in the matter at this stage, writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent No.2-school to update the records and by incorporating the name of her son as Bikramjeet Singh Bhangu instead of Bikramjeet Singh and to thereafter approach the Central Board of Secondary Education seeking necessary correction in the Matriculation as also Senior Secondary Examination certificates.

Disposed of.
