Prayer in this application filed under Section 151 CPC is for preponing the hearing and to dispose of the matter in terms of compromise arrived at between the appellant-claimants and respondent No.2-Insurance Company.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed and the hearing of main case, which is otherwise fixed for 17.08.2018, is preponed and the case is taken on board today itself.

Appellant-claimants have filed the present appeal impugning the award dated 07.11.2015 whereby on account of death of Anil, the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sonipat (for short, 'the Tribunal') has awarded compensation of ₹5,60,000/- along with interest @ 9% per annum from the date of filing of petition till its actual realization.

Learned counsel for the appellant-claimants argues that during the pendency of present appeal, matter has been compromised between the parties and as per the terms of compromise, Insurance Company has agreed to pay a sum of ₹3,10,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal. This additional amount of ₹3,10,000/- shall be in full and final settlement of the claim.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-Insurance Company states that so far as the awarded amount by the Tribunal is concerned, the same has already been deposited, whereas the additional amount of ₹3,10,000/- shall be deposited before the Lok Adalat Branch of this Court within next six weeks from today.

In view of aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.2-Insurance Company, present appeal is disposed of. A cheque for the agreed amount shall be made in the name of appellant No.2, namely, Krishana wife of Randhir Singh, who is the mother of deceased Anil and the account payee cheque shall be handed over to the claimants within six weeks from today.
