The petitioners are co-sharer in the land and allege that other co-owners are raising construction in violation of Punjab New Capital (Periphery) Control Act. In this regard, they initially filed a civil suit which was withdrawn on technical grounds but with a liberty to file a fresh one. The petitioners would thus have a remedy of filing a civil suit for redressal of their grievance.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioners to avail themselves of their remedies in law. Needless to say that the petitioners are also at liberty to pursue their remedy with the respondents to whom the grievance has been informed.
