JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (*Sarbpreet Singh*) is serving in rank of Under Secretary with the Punjab Vidhan Sabha. By filing the present writ petition, he is seeking quashing of the Charge Sheet dated 18.10.2018 (**Annexure P-11**) and the subsequent order dated 22.11.2018 (**Annexure P-13**), whereby an Enquiry Officer stands appointed.

The substratum of the allegations is that the petitioner in the criminal trial against Mr. Anil Vij, *inter alia*, with regard to entrustment of an amount of ₹ 10,00,000/- (Ten Lacs only), had not stated in his examination-in-chief with regard to the withdrawal of the amount of ₹ 10,00,000/- (Ten Lacs only) from the bank and handing it over to the then Secretary, as also the subsequent handing in his presence to Mr. Anil Vij, leading to acquittal of said Mr. Anil Vij.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from his client, **prays** for permission to **withdraw** the present petition with a prayer to supply of required record.

“Dismissed as Withdrawn”.

The ancillary prayer for the non-supply of the required record, the petitioner would have full opportunity during the enquiry to summon the relevant record in accordance with law.
