JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (*Mrs. Anukampa Behal*) is working as JBT Teacher on deputation basis with Chandigarh Administration since 06.07.2010 and her parent department is the Directorate of Secondary Education, Punjab.

By filing the present writ petition, the petitioner is claiming the ACP benefit on completion of nine (09) and fourteen (14) years of service, i.e., 17.12.2010 and 17.12.2015, respectively.

It is claimed that vide order dated 01.06.2016 (**Annexure P-2**) issued by the District Education Officer, Chandigarh Administration, ACP benefits, no doubt, have been granted w.e.f. 18.12.2010 on completion of nine (09) years' service, however, without specifying the sanctioned arrears of the benefit.

Upon notice, Mr. Sanjeev Ghai, Panel Advocate, Chandigarh Administration, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent(s) and states that the arrears on account of grant of ACP benefit on completion of nine (09) years w.e.f. 18.12.2010 have since been released; as also the due arrears on completion of fourteen (14) years of ACP benefit w.e.f.

18.12.2015.

In view of the stand of the counsel for respondent-Chandigarh Administration, it is agreed that nothing more survives for adjudication in the present petition and the same has become infructuous.

“Disposed of as Infructuous”.

Respondent-Chandigarh Administration shall be bound by its stand as taken.
