This appeal is filed against the judgment and decree dated 17.10.2015 passed by the Guardian Judge, Ferozepur by which petition filed under Section 7 (X) of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 by the biological parents of minor Ankur to appoint them his guardian of his person and property. In the said petition, another petition was filed by Pardeep Kumar, brother of the adoptive parents of minor Ankur. Both the petitions were heard together and petition filed by the biological parents was allowed and that of Pardeep Kumar was dismissed.

It is an admitted fact that during the pendency of this appeal, the minor Ankur has attained the age of majority as per Indian Majority Act, 1875. Thus, in view thereof, the appeal filed by the uncle

of minor Ankur namely, Pardeep Kumar for appointing him as a guardian of his person and property has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
