Mr. Chetan Mittal, Sr. Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner-M/s A.B. Sugars Ltd. has decided to purchase the sugar cane from the farmers and apply for licence to run the mill for the crushing year 2018-2019 in view of the decision taken by the State Govt. on 5.12.2018. Aforesaid contention is not controverted by the State counsel.

State counsel submits that no action is likely to be taken pursuant to order under Section 133 Cr.P.C. as the same may be unsustainable in law.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives in this petition. Same has been rendered infructuous. Dismissed as such.
