The petitioner is an inhabitant of Village Sunjarpur, Tehsil Bawal District Rewari who has approached this Court with a grievance that a petition filed by respondent No. 3 against respondents No. 4 and 5 under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulations) Act, 1961 (for short 'the Act') for seeking their eviction from the land of the Gram Panchayat (*rasta sareeam*), pending before respondent No. 2, is not making any headway.

It is submitted that the said petition was filed in the year 2015 and now it is fixed for 17.12.2018. It is further submitted that no substantial proceedings have been carried out by respondent No. 2 except for adjourning the case time and again.

Thus, learned counsel for the petitioner has made an innocuous prayer for issuance of an order to expedite the trial of the aforesaid petition, pending before respondent No. 2.

Keeping in view the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, we do not find any necessity to issue notice to the respondents but

still, on our asking Mr. Sandeep Moudgil, Addl. A.G., Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 and submitted that a direction may be issued to respondent No. 2 as prayed for.

Hence, this petition is dispose off with a direction to respondent No. 2, to decide the application filed under Section 7 of the Act, pending before him, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
