This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned notice dated 23.10.2018 (Annexure P-15) and the auction scheduled for 20.12.2018.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that certain questions of fact are required to be established and prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner either to approach the Civil court or to avail the alternative remedies as are available to him in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to him, in accordance with law.
