The petitioners are seeking benefit of regularization keeping in view that petitioner No. 1 was appointed as Baildar on 05.02.1996 on daily wages, petitioner No. 2 was appointed as Baildar on 22.05.1996 and petitioner No. 3 was appointed as Mali-cum-Chowkidar on daily wages in the year 1994.

The grievance of the petitioners is that their juniors have been regularized as per details given in para 4 of the writ petition and the case of the petitioners for regularization has not been considered till date and they are squarely covered by all the conditions of regularization policy dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-2).

A legal notice dated 09.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) has been sent in this regard.

Ms. Palika Monga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

This petition is being disposed of giving direction to the respondents to decide legal notice dated 09.09.2018 (Annexure P-4) following the judgment passed by this Court in ***CWP-2009-2016 Balwinder Singh and others V/s. State of Haryana and others*** and pass appropriate orders within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order failing which Rs.50,000/- will be deposited in the account of each petitioner.
